FOR CAR PARK USERS**

TAXIS/PARENTS' CARS am

1. Please drive down to the end by the exit, keeping to the right side of the car park.
2. Please do use the 'parent pull in bay' (signposted in the car park) if you need to talk to a member of staff or need more time to unload.
3. Please do not block access to the pedestrian path or the marked zebra crossing.
4. If asked to move round, in order to let the Skanska buses in, please do so and re-enter the car park.
5. Switch your engine off when you have stopped.
6. Do not let your passengers out until you are one of the first four cars in line.
7. Please escort your passenger into the school's front entrance.
7. Once your passenger has been handed over to a member of Dysart staff, go straight back to your car and drive off.

TAXIS/PARENTS' CARS pm

1. Please drive down to the end by the exit, keeping to the right side of the car park. Switch your engine off
2. Please do use the 'parent pull in bay' (signposted in the car park) if you need to talk to a member of staff or need more time to unload.
3. Please do not block access to the pedestrian path or the marked zebra crossing.
4. If asked to move round, in order to let the Skanska buses in, please do so and re-enter the car park.
5. Please wait at your vehicle to meet your passenger as the pupils will be brought out in the order of the vehicles. As soon as they are on board, please drive off, if it is safe to do so.

- Buses have designated parking areas to assist with traffic flow and reduce congestion
- Speed limit 5mph.

5. Please check you have the right pupils before you drive off.
6. Please do not drive off until the taxis have gone and your exit is completely clear.
